Figures show the percent of the student body from grades K-3rd falling within the percentile ranges. **All New City students were tested.**

Summary: The vast majority of New City students scored above the 51st percentile in all areas tested. For both Total Achievement and for the Broad Math scores 93% of the students were above the 51st percentile. Broad Reading scores are more dependent on a student's home environment and the richness of vocabulary to which students are exposed before entering school. 71% of the students were working at or above the 51st percentile in this area.

We believe that the educational processes in place at New City are highly effective for students from under-resourced households and we fully expect to see these students continue to improve their individual percentile ranking with each passing year at New City Christian School.
